## Group A



Saint Martín and Sint Maarten will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

Saint Martín will take part in its second qualifiers after competing in the 2025 edition. Its historical record stands at two defeats and one victory, with the lone win coming in a 4-1 result against Bonaire in Group D on 15-Feb-2025 at Estadio Francisco Morazán in San Pedro Sula (HON). The goals for San Martín were scored by **Tylian Vilar** and **Jahnael Charlery-Adele** x3, while **Darryn Isenia** pulled one back for Bonaire. Likewise, this will be its third matchup against a Caribbean team (1L-1W); the defeat was a 3-0 loss to Puerto Rico on 12-Feb-2025 at Estadio Francisco Morazán in San Pedro Sula (HON), in Group D, with goals scored by **Eddiel Márquez** x2 and **Adjani van Putten**.

Sint Maarten will also compete in its second qualifiers after participating in the 2025 edition, where it suffered four defeats without scoring a goal, conceding 28 goals (7 goals per match). This will be its fourth match against a Caribbean opponent (0W-0D-3L-0-GF-16-GA). Sint Maarten, along with Martinique, are the only teams to have lost all their matches without scoring a goal.



Trinidad & Tobago and Barbados will meet for the second time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

In the 2023 edition, they were Group F opponents on 15-Feb-2023 in the first phase of the tournament at Estadio Pensativo in Antigua Guatemala (GUA), drawing 1-1. Barbados' goal was scored by **Shamari Harewood**, while **Lindell Sween** found the net for the Trinidadians.

Trinidad & Tobago is on a seven-match unbeaten streak against Caribbean teams (4W-3D), with the last two matches ending in victories: a 3-1 win against the British Virgin Islands (9-Feb-2025, **Josiah Kallicharan** x2, **Qu'yl Billingy / Zeveih Abraham**) and a 9-0 victory against Sint Maarten (13-Feb-2025, **Josiah Kallicharan** x3, **Sheridan McNish, Adam Pierre, Timothy Valtentine, Criston Gómez, Caden Trestrail, Nikosi Foncette**).

Barbados has faced Caribbean teams three times in the qualifiers at any stage and remains unbeaten (2D-1W). The most recent match against these teams marked its only historical victory, a 1-0 win over Dominica on 11-Feb-2025 in Group C, played at the FEMEXFUT venue, with a goal by **Kimani Rodney**.



Sint Maarten and Mexico will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

Sint Maarten will face a North American national team for the first time in the history of the qualifiers, with Mexico becoming the sixth different opponent Sint Maarten has faced in the tournament's history.

Mexico has played 32 matches against Caribbean teams in the history of the qualifiers at any stage and remains unbeaten (4D-28W). El Tri is on a 13-match winning streak against these teams in any phase, with 62 goals scored (4.8 goals per match) and three goals conceded.

The only matches in which Mexico failed to defeat a Caribbean team were: a 0-0 draw against Trinidad & Tobago (1-Sep-1983, semifinal), a 0-0 draw against Jamaica (24-Mar-1991, first phase), a 1-1 draw against Cuba (21-Aug-1992, Samuel Terrés for Mexico and **Léster Quesada** for Cuba, final round-robin), and a 0-0 draw against Haiti (6-Apr-2007, Group A).

Sint Maarten will face a North American national team for the first time in the history of the qualifiers, with Mexico becoming the sixth different opponent Sint Maarten has faced in the tournament's history.

The only matches in which Mexico failed to defeat a Caribbean team were: a 0-0 draw against Trinidad & Tobago (1-Sep-1983, semifinal), a 0-0 draw against Jamaica (24-Mar-1991, first phase), a 1-1 draw against Cuba (21-Aug-1992, **Samuel Terrés** for Mexico and **Léster Quesada** for Cuba, final round-robin), and a 0-0 draw against Haiti (6-Apr-2007, Group A).



## Barbados vs Sint Maarten



Barbados and Sint Maarten will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

Barbados has played four Matchday 3 group-stage matches in the tournament's history, posting a record of one win, one draw, and two losses. The team is unbeaten in its last two such matches (1D-1W), drawing 1-1 against Trinidad & Tobago (goal by **Shamari Harewood** for Barbados and **Lindell Sween** for the Trinidadians) on 15-Feb-2023, and earning a 1-0 win over Dominica (own goal by Kimani Rodney) on 11-Feb-2025.

Meanwhile, Sint Maarten will contest Matchday 3 of the group stage for the second time in its history. In the previous appearance, it fell 3-0 to Guyana on 11-Feb-2025 (Group B) at Estadio Alejandro Morera Soto in Alajuela (CRC), with goals by **Shaquan David**, **Quaency Fraser**, and **Jaden Harris**.



## México vs Saint Martín



Mexico and Saint Martin will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

This will be Mexico's 22nd Matchday 3 group-stage match, and the team remains unbeaten (4D-18W). Mexico has won its last two such matches, an 8-0 victory over Dominica (goals by **Gael Álvarez**, **Jonathan Grajales**, **Aldo de Nigris Jr.** x2, **Luis Gamboa**, **José Mencilla**, **Daniel Núñez** from the penalty spot, and **Juan Carlos Rangel**) on 9-Feb-2025, and a 3-0 win against Belize (goals by **Luis Gamboa**, **Máximo Reyes**, and **Jorge Sánchez**) on 11-Feb-2025. Mexico's only draws in Matchday 3 came in a 1-1 result against Honduras on 6-May-2001, a 0-0 draw on 8-Apr-2007, a 1-1 draw against Canada (**Claudio Zamudio** for Canada and Barlon Sequeira for Mexico) on 6-Mar-2015, and a 1-1 draw against Panama (**Yerar Azcárate** for Mexico and **Anel Ryce** for Panama) on 15-Feb-2023.

Saint Martin will contest Matchday 3 of the group stage for the second time, with its only previous appearance resulting in its first victory, a 4-1 win over Bonaire on 15-Feb-2025. The goals were scored by **Tylian Vilar** and **Jahnael Charlery-Adele** x3 for Saint Martin, while **Darryn Isenia** scored for Bonaire.



## Sint Maarten vs Trinidad & Tobago



Sint Maarten and Trinidad & Tobago will meet again in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers following the Soca Warriors' 9-0 victory in Group B on 13-Feb-2025 at Estadio Alejandro Morera Soto in Alajuela (CRC), with goals by **Josiah Kallicharan x3, Sheridan McNish, Adam Pierre, Timothy Valentine, Criston Gomez, Caden Trestail**, and **Nikosi Foncette**.

Trinidad & Tobago will contest a Matchday 4 group-stage match for the fifth time in the tournament's history (3W-1D). Against a Caribbean opponent, it will be the third such meeting (1L-1W). The only victory was the aforementioned 9-0 win against Sint Maarten (Group B, 13-Feb-2025), while the defeat was a 5-1 loss to Jamaica (Group A, 8-Mar-2015), with goals by **Peter Vassell, Nathaniel Adamolekun, Tajea Brown x2, and Donovan Dawkins** for the Jamaicans, while **Noah Powder** pulled one back for the Trinidadians.



## Barbados vs México



Barbados and Mexico will meet for the second time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers. In the previous meeting, Mexico earned a 6-0 victory in Group C on 13-Feb-2025 at the FEMEXFUT Central Venue, with goals by **Viggo Ortiz** from the penalty spot, **Saulo Tejeda, Juan Carlos Rangel, Aldo de Nigris x2, and Máximo Reye**.

Mexico will face a Caribbean team on Matchday 4 of the group stage for the third time in the tournament's history. The young "Aztecs" have won both previous encounters without conceding a goal, scoring eight goals in total, defeating Haiti 2-0 (9-Mar-2015, goals by **Pablo López and Francisco Venegas**) and the aforementioned 6-0 victory over Barbados (13-Feb-2025).



## Saint Martín vs Barbados



Saint Martin and Barbados will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

The Saint Martin national team will make its debut in a Matchday 5 group-stage fixture in the tournament's history. The 2026 edition will become the competition in which Saint Martin has played the most matches (five games), after competing in only three matches in the 2025 edition (1W-0D-2L).

For Barbados, this will be the second time in its tournament history that it contests Matchday 5 of the group stage, having previously earned a 4-3 victory against Belize on 16-Feb-2025 in Group C at the FEMEXFUT Central Venue. The goals were scored by **Deifson Cartagena** (own

goal), **Tariq Barker**, and **Tyrico Redman-Bellamy** x2 (one from the penalty spot), while Belize's goals were netted by **Marlon Meza** x2 and **Jamal Herrera**.



México vs Trinidad & Tobago



The rivalry between Mexico and Trinidad & Tobago will add another chapter in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers. Mexico leads the series with four wins and one draw. The four victories were consecutive.

### Results:

1-1 on 1-Sep-1983 (semifinals), Trinidad & Tobago won on penalty kicks 5-4 and advanced to the final, which it later lost on penalties 5-3 against the United States.

2-0 on 2-Apr-1991 (final round-robin), goals by **Joel "El Tiburón" Sánchez** and **Rafael "El Chiquis" García**.

6-2 on 12-Feb-1999 (Group B, first phase).

7-0 on 22-Apr-2009 (Group B, first phase), goals by **Carlos Campos**, **Martín Galván** x3 (1 from the penalty spot), **Víctor Mañón**, **Luis Télles**, and **Salvador Jasso**.

5-0 on 5-May-2019 (Group E, first phase), goals by **Bryan González**, **Santiago Muñoz** x2, and **Efraín Álvarez** x2.
