Bermuda



vs Guyana

A first-ever meeting in the history of the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers.

For the third time in the tournament's history, Bermuda will face a Caribbean team on the opening matchday of the group stage, having lost the previous two.

Results:

3-1 loss to Trinidad & Tobago on 1-May-2019 (goals by **Justin Araujo x2** and **Andrew de Gannes** for the Soca Warriors, and **Nazuri Dailey** for Bermuda).

6-1 loss to Curaçao on 7-Feb-2025 (own goals by **Joseph Carolo** and **Dakari Smith-David**, goals by **D'Shawn Anastasia**, **Dayvi Busby x2**, and **Taysison Bregita** for Curaçao, and a penalty goal by **Kennahz Fray** for Bermuda).

Guyana will face a Caribbean team on the opening matchday of the group stage for the second time in the tournament's history, following a 1-1 draw against Trinidad & Tobago on 7-Feb-2025 at Estadio Alejandro Morera Soto in Alajuela (CRC), with a goal by **Joshua Morris** for Guyana and **Phillip Nelson** for Trinidad & Tobago.

vs Suriname

Honduras and Suriname will meet for the second time in the history of the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers. In the first meeting, the Catrachos earned a 6-1 victory on 12-Feb-2023 in Group H, at Estadio Pensativo in Antigua Guatemala (GUA). Honduras' goals were scored by **Nixon Cruz**, **Nayrobi Vargas**, **Bryan Sáenz**, **Edwin Munguía x2** (one from the penalty spot), and **Roberto Osorio**, while **Jermaine Goodett** scored for Suriname.

Honduras will open the group stage against a Caribbean team for the 10th time, holding a record of five wins, three losses, and one draw (5W-3L-1D). Honduras has recorded two consecutive victories in such matches: a 6-1 win over Suriname on 12-Feb-2023 and a 3-1 victory against

Saint Martin on 10-Feb-2025 (goals by **Jason Arriola**, **David Flores**, and an own goal by **Emmanuel Martín**, along with a goal by **Marco Antonio Reyes**).

Suriname will face a Central American team on the opening matchday of the tournament for the second time in its history, with the first being the 6-1 defeat to Honduras on 12-Feb-2023.

For the second time, Suriname will face a Caribbean team on Matchday 2 of the group stage, following a 3-0 defeat to Haiti on 14-Feb-2023 (Group H) at Estadio Pensativo in Antigua Guatemala (GUA). The goals were scored by **Sebastien Joseph**, **Schneilorens Lebrun**, and **Samuel Lamare**.

For Bermuda, this will be the second time it faces a Caribbean team on Matchday 2 of the group stage. On 9-Feb-2025, it earned a 3-1 victory over Anguilla (Group A) at the National Sports Centre of Bermuda (BER), with goals by **Kennahz Fray x2** and **Logan Jiménez** for Bermuda, while **Amir Brangman** scored for Anguilla.



Honduras defeated Guyana 3-0 in the only meeting in the history of the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers on 3-May-2019 (Group G) at Field #11 of the IMG Academy in Bradenton (USA), with goals by **Jeffry Miranda x2** and **Miguel Carrasco**.

Guyana has been unable to win in its three matches against Central American teams (2L-1D). The draw was a 2-2 result against Costa Rica on 13-Feb-2025 (Group B) at Estadio Alejandro Morera Soto in Alajuela (CRC), with goals by **Max Robinson** and **Marcus Brown** for Costa Rica, while **Joshua Morris** and **Shaquan David** scored for Guyana.

Honduras holds a record of 9 wins, 1 loss, and 1 draw (9W-1L-1D) in Matchday 2 group-stage matches against Caribbean teams. The Catrachos are on a six-match unbeaten run (6W-1D), winning their last four matches: 3-0 vs. Curaçao (24-Apr-2017), 3-0 vs. Guyana (3-May-2019), 4-1 vs. Trinidad & Tobago (8-May-2019), and 8-0 vs. Bonaire (12-Feb-2019).

Guyana will face Caribbean teams on the final matchday of the group stage for the third time in the tournament's history (1L-1D). The loss was a 6-0 defeat to Haiti on 5-May-2019 (goals by **Michel Pierre x2** [one from the penalty spot], **Kervens Jolicoeur, Kurowskybob Fertil, Omre Etienne**, and **Thero Rhinvil** from the penalty spot), and the draw was a 1-1 result against the British Virgin Islands on 16-Feb-2025 (goal by **Jaden Harris** for Guyana and **Luca Stuttard** for the British Virgin Islands).

It will be the first time in the tournament's history that Suriname faces a Caribbean team on the final matchday of the group stage. Suriname has lost all its final group-stage matches without scoring a goal and has conceded 12 goals.

Results:

2-0 loss to Canada on 28-Apr-2017 (**Jonathan David x2**).

6-0 loss to Costa Rica on 6-May-2019 (**Geancarlo Castro x3, Manfred Ugalde, Keymark Davis, Jean Carlo Alvarado**).

4-0 loss to El Salvador on 16-Feb-2023 (**Bryan Vásquez, Christopher Argueta, Cristoper Arias, Nelson Díaz**).



Honduras defeated Bermuda 6-0 in the only meeting between the two teams in the Concacaf Men's Under-17 Qualifiers, on 19-Feb-2023 in the Round of 16 at Estadio Doroteo Guamuch Flores in Guatemala City (GUA), with goals by **Russel Cruz, Edwin Munguía, Roberto Osorio, Nixon Cruz, Jordan García**, and **Nayrobi Vargas**.

Honduras is unbeaten in final group-stage matches against Caribbean teams, holding a record of seven wins and two draws (7W-2D), and has recorded four consecutive victories: 2-0 vs. Trinidad & Tobago on 5-Mar-2015 (**Dylan Andrade, Wisdom Quaye**), 3-1 vs. Haiti on 27-Apr-2017 (**Emerson López, Carlos "Zapatilla" Mejía, Luis Palma; Obenson Leveillé** scored for Haiti), 1-0 vs. Haiti on 16-Feb-2023 (**Russel Cruz**), and 1-0 vs. Puerto Rico on 15-Feb-2025 (**Jason Arriola**).

Bermuda will face a Central American team on the final matchday of the group stage for the second time in the tournament's history, following an 8-1 defeat to Costa Rica on 20-Aug-1996 in Group 1 in Port of Spain (TRI).
