TRI 2-4 GUF (20-AUG-1978), GUF 1-4 TRI (2-SEP-1978), the 1978 Nations Cup Qualifying Phase in Trinidad & Tobago; GUF 0-1 TRI (23-JUL-1983), Final Round of the 1983 Nations Cup in French Guiana; GUF 1-3 TRI (10-MAY-1989), Group A of the 1989 Caribbean Cup Qualifying Phase; TRI 4-1 GUF (10-OCT-2012), 2012 Caribbean Cup Qualification Phase; and TRI 4-2 GUF (13-NOV-2014), in Group 1 of the 2014 Caribbean Cup.

Trinidad and Tobago defeated Montserrat 6–1 in the first round, 2 July 2021. (Kevin Molino, Marcus Joseph, Ryan Telfer, Judah Garcia and Reon Dale x2; Lyle Taylor).

Participations in Gold Cup: 11th (1991, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2002, 2005, 2007, 2013, 2015, 2019 & 2021).

Best result in Gold Cup: 3rd place 2000.

Head coach: Angus Eve (TRI). 48 years. Record: 1 GP: 1W-0T-0L. He is a former footballer for the Trinidad and Tobago national team. As a player he scored 34 goals in 117 games for the national team. He played in 4 editions of the Gold Cup (1996, 2000, 2002 and 2005 (2W-2T-6L). In 2011, he was appointed coach of the Trinidad and Tobago U-23 National Team for the CONCACAF Pre-Olympics.

Best result in Gold Cup: 6-1 win over Montserrat (Kevin Molino, Marcus Joseph, Ryan Telfer, Judah García and Reon Dale x2; Lyle Taylor), in Round 1 of the 2021 Gold Cup Prelims, at DRV PNK Stadium in Fort Lauderdale (2-JUL-2021).

Defea with most goals in Gold Cup: 6-0 vs. United States (Aaron Long x2, Gyasi Zardes x2, Christian Pulisic and Paul Arriola), Group D, (22-JUN 2019), Cleveland's FirstEnergy Stadium.

Gold Cup record: G-4 W-1 T-0 L-3 (GF-5 GC-10). 25% effectiveness. *Concacaf officially awarded 3-0 vs. Cuba win in Round 1 of the preliminaries.

Gold Cup participations: 2 (2017 & 2021).

Best result in Gold Cup: Group stage 2017.

Head coach: Thierry De Neef (GUF), 54 years old. Record: 14 GP (6W-2T-6L). He has been the coach of French Guiana since April 2018. Born in Paris (FRA) he played for GUF in 3 matches in the Concacaf Gold Cup Qualifying Stage in 2005. He started his coaching career at Club Sportif et Culturel de Cayenne (2007-2013).

Top scorer in Gold Cup: Sloan Privat & Roy Contout (1).

Youngest Gold Cup scorer: Sloan Privat vs. Canada at 27 years, 11 months and 11 days (Group A, 2017).

Oldest gold cup scorer: Roy Contout vs. Canada at 28 years, 4 months and 25 days (Group A, 2017).
