



Milestones & Records January 2027



St. Vincent & the Grenadines 0-15 Honduras



- The **St. Vincent & the Grenadines national team** suffered the **heaviest defeat in its history** in the tournament across **any phase**, surpassing the **0–7 loss to Jamaica (August 6, 2017)**.
- **St. Vincent & the Grenadines** reached **six defeats in six matches played** in the history of the tournament and, along with the **U.S. Virgin Islands**, are the **only teams to have lost every match** in the competition's history.
- **Honduras** recorded its **largest victory ever** in the history of the Qualifiers across **any phase**, surpassing the **12–0 win against Anguilla (November 1, 2021)**.
- Honduras became the **second Central American team** to score **15 goals in a single match** in the history of the tournament, following **Costa Rica's 15–0 win against Belize (November 13, 2015)**.
- The **15–0 win by Honduras** stands as the **second-largest victory by a Central American team** in the history of the tournament, only behind **Costa Rica's 16–0 win against the U.S. Virgin Islands (January 25, 2026)**.
- **Alexandra Merriam (HON)** reached **nine goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament and, for the **first time**, scored **five goals in a single match** for her national team.
- **Nohemy Meza (HON)** reached **six goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament, scored **six goals in a single match for the first time**, and became the **first Honduran player** to score **six goals in one match** in this phase, the **highest single-match goal total** ever recorded by a Honduran player in the competition.
- **Allisson Suazo (HON)** reached **three goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament and recorded her **first career brace**.
- **Valentina Chavarría (HON)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.



Antigua & Barbuda 0-5 Guatemala



- **Kaylee Luna (GUA)** scored her **first two goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament, recording her **first career brace**.
- **Dulce Escobar (GUA)**, **Mónica Martínez (GUA)**, and **Mayra Avendaño (GUA)** each scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.
- This marked the **fourth 5–0 defeat** for **Antigua & Barbuda** in the history of the Qualifiers across **any phase**, making it the **most frequent losing scoreline** for the team.
- The match represented **Antigua & Barbuda's first-ever match against a Central American national team** in the history of the tournament, resulting in its **first defeat** against opposition from the region.
- **Antigua & Barbuda** made its **fifth historical appearance** in the Qualifiers and, for the **third time**, opened a tournament edition with **two consecutive defeats**: **2008 (0–3 vs. Cayman Islands and 0–7 vs. Jamaica)**, **2012 (0–10 vs. Bahamas and 0–5 vs. Bermuda)**, and **2026 (1–6 vs. Haiti and 0–5 vs. Guatemala)**.
- **Guatemala** recorded its **fourth consecutive victory against Caribbean national teams** in the history of the Qualifiers across **any phase**, establishing its **best-ever streak** against teams from the region and equaling its **longest winning streak (four matches)** against **Central American opponents**.
- **Guatemala** reached **25 matches played** in the history of the Qualifiers across **all phases**, holding an all-time record of **10 wins, 0 draws, and 15 losses**, with **55 goals scored and 68 goals conceded**.



British Virgin Islands 0-8 Cuba



- The **British Virgin Islands** reached **eight defeats in eight matches played** in the history of the tournament, a **unique record**, as **no other national team** has posted a similar mark in the competition.
- **Cuba** scored **eight goals in a single match** of the tournament in **any phase** for the **second time** in its history, following the **8–0 win against Guyana on August 13, 2017**, marking the **highest goal total ever scored by the Cuban team** in a single match of the competition.
- Cuba scored **12 goals in its first two matches** of the tournament, setting a **new all-time high** for the national team over its **first two matches** in tournament history: **4–3 vs. Grenada (January 25, 2026)** and **8–0 vs. British Virgin Islands (January 27, 2026)**, surpassing the **11 goals scored in 2015 (6–0 vs. Cayman Islands on July 15, 2015 and 5–1 vs. Bahamas on July 17, 2015)**.

- **Dedina Sheila (CUB), Emely Díaz (CUB), Dayana Ayala (CUB), and Yoesmayda Isaac (CUB)** each scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.

- **Stella Strutton (BVI)** recorded her **first own goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament, on this occasion **in favor of Cuba**.

- **Yaiselis López (CUB)** reached **nine goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament and has scored **seven goals in the current edition**, the **most ever scored by a Cuban player in a single edition** of the Qualifiers at this stage, surpassing the **five goals** scored by **Yilianny Sablón** and **Lilian Pérez**, both in **2016**.



Saint Lucia 0-5 Haiti



- With the defeat, **Saint Lucia** saw its **longest unbeaten run** in the history of the tournament come to an end (**1 win, 1 draw**), following the **5–0 victory against Aruba (August 24, 2017)** and the **1–1 draw against Antigua & Barbuda (August 26, 2017)**.

- Saint Lucia lost by a **5–0 scoreline for the second time** in the history of the tournament across **any phase**, following the defeat against **Suriname on July 15, 2015**. It also marked the **second-highest number of goals conceded** by Saint Lucia in the competition, only behind the **14 goals conceded in the 14–0 loss to Jamaica on July 17, 2015**.

- The result represented **Haiti's 15th victory by a margin of five goals or more** in the history of the tournament across **any phase**.

- **Kyrah Lormil (HAI)** and **Keisha Gue (HAI)** reached **three goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.

- **Krystel Chatelain (HAI)** and **Rosalie St. Louis (HAI)** scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.



Aruba 0-2 Jamaica



- **Ricquanna Richards (JAM)** and **Elizabeth Miller (JAM)** scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.

- **Aruba** suffered its **eighth consecutive defeat** in the history of the tournament across **any phase** and, with the loss, recorded **nine defeats in ten matches played** in the competition; its **only victory** was a **4–0 win against Curaçao (October 14, 2009)**.

- **Jamaica** recorded its **third win in three matches** against **Aruba** in the history of the tournament across **any phase**, keeping a **clean sheet** in all meetings: **8–0 (October 12, 2009)**, **9–0 (August 25, 2011)**, and **2–0 (January 27, 2026)**.

- Jamaica recorded its **second victory in its last seven matches** played in the competition across **any phase** (**3 losses, 2 wins, and 2 draws**), a **first-of-its-kind stretch** in the nation's tournament history.



Anguilla 0-13 Costa Rica



- **Nicole Hernández (CRC)** and **Cameron Mora (CRC)** scored their **second goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.

- **Lucía Paniagua (CRC)** reached **11 goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round and, for the **first time**, recorded a **hat trick**.

- **Nubia Medina (CRC)** reached **11 goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round; it marked the **second time** she scored **five goals in a single match** in the current Qualifiers and made her the **first Costa Rican player** to score **five goals in consecutive matches** in the history of this phase.

- **Nubia Medina (CRC)** is **Costa Rica's all-time leading scorer** with **10 goals**, the **assists leader** with **four**, and also leads the **overall tournament scoring chart**. Alongside **Yoesmayda Isaac (CUB)**, **Jazmyn Díaz (DOM)**, and **Stefany Miranda (NCA)**, she also tops the **assists leaderboard (4)**.

- **Emma Azofeifa (CRC)** reached her **fourth goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.

- **Celeste González (CRC)** and **Stacy Venegas (CRC)** scored their **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.

- **Anguilla** reached **11 consecutive matches without a win** in the history of the tournament across **any phase** (**2 draws, 9 losses**) and, for the **first time**, recorded a run of **five consecutive defeats** in its Qualifiers history.

- The result marked the **third-largest victory** for **Costa Rica** in the history of the tournament across **any phase**, only behind the **15–0 win vs. Belize (November 13, 2015)** and the **16–0 win vs. the British Virgin Islands (January 27, 2026)**.
