

## América (MEX) vs. Santa Fe FC (PAN)

Club América has a win against Vancouver Whitecaps at home and a loss against Portland Thorns away prior to week three of the CWCC. In their home debut for the CWCC 2024-25, they triumphed 7-0 over Vancouver Whitecaps (goals by Sarah Luebbert, Nicolette Hernández, Kiana Palacios, Scarlett Camberos, Irene Guerrero, Aylín Aviléz, and Miah Zuazua) at Estadio Ciudad de los Deportes, Mexico City.

The América women's team has scored 8 goals and provided two assists in Group B, achieving a shot effectiveness of 27.6%.

## Highlighted players:

- **Sabrina Enciso (USA):** Led with 114 completed passes in the 3-1 defeat to Thorns and is the team leader in assists with 3.

- Irene Guerrero (ESP): Participated in the goals in the previous two weeks with 3 shots (1 goal against Whitecaps and Thorns).
- **Sarah Luebbert (USA)**: Scored 1 goal and provided 1 assist against Vancouver Whitecaps. She also leads the team in shots with 7 (4 on target, 1 goal, 1 shot to the posts, and 1 miss).



## SANTA FE FC (PAN)

Santa Fe FC has lost their previous two matches (2-0 against San Diego Wave and 2-1 against Vancouver Whitecaps, both at the Rommel Fernández Stadium in Panama City. The Panamanian champions will play their first away match in the CWCC 2024-25.

Santa Fe FC has conceded two goals per game (two in each half) and has faced 18 shots in two matches. The Panamanian team scored one goal from 16 shots (eight in each half of the game). The team coached by Argentine Fernando Clavero has received 24 fouls in their two matches.

## **Highlighted players:**

- María Murillo (PAN): Made 4 shots, one of which ended in a goal against Vancouver Whitecaps. The defender contributed 5 clearances and completed 71% of her passes.
- **Erika Largo (COL**): Had the most shots in the match against Vancouver (4), two of which were on target and two missed. She has a pass effectiveness of 82%, with 55 effective passes in the last game.
- **Miluska Guevara (PAN)**: Has started the first two matches for Santa Fe FC. The midfielder has made 66 passes, 55 of which were effective.
