Ouanaminthe (HAI) vs. Grenades FC (ATG)

They will face each other for the first time in the Concacaf Caribbean Cup and in their history.



Ouanaminthe FC will play its third match in its debut tournament at the CCC 2024. Coached by Joseph Roudy (HAI), the team will seek its first victory. The Haitian club has averaged 15.5 shots in the current competition (scored 2 goals, made 12 shots on goal, 16 off-target shots, and 1 hit the posts) with a shooting accuracy of 6.5%.

They will play their second home game of the tournament. They drew 1-1 against AC Port of Spain (Joseph Willinx; Shackiel Smek Henry) in their official debut in the competition, at the Moca 85 Stadium.

How the goals were scored in CCC 2024: Play (1), Header (1),

Players to watch:

Fredelin Philistin (HAI). Scored the temporary equalizing goal in the 3-1 loss to Moca in Round 3 and had the most shots of the match (4). The 19-year-old striker has made 2 appearances in the tournament.

Sinor Louibenn (HAI). The 25-year-old midfielder leads the overall shooting chart for Ouanaminthe in the CONCACAF tournament with 6 shots in 197 minutes played (50% on target). He completed 75 accurate passes in the competition.

Widjoly Minoche (HAI). He has recovered the most balls (17) in the competition. The 19-year-old player made 74 passes in the tournament with an accuracy of 91%. He totaled 4 shots in the Caribbean Cup.



GRENADES FC (ATG)

Grenades FC will play their 3rd match in their debut tournament at the CCC 2024. They earned their first point last round when they drew 1-1 against AC Port of Spain in Port of Spain. Additionally, they were defeated in their debut against Cibao FC: 1-2 (Sherman Augustin; Jean López and Edippo Rodríguez) at the Estadio de Cibao, Santiago de los Caballeros.

The team based in Antigua and Barbuda will play away for the second time. They have scored 2 goals, both in the second half (they were behind at halftime in both matches).

The champions of the Antigua and Barbuda First Division 2022/23 have won 4 of their last 7 matches in Concacaf club tournaments. They will seek their first win in the history of the tournament. Their last victory in an international tournament was against Dublanc (Sherman Augustin) in the semifinals of the Caribbean Club Shield 2024.

Players to watch:

Sean Tomlinson (ATG). Scored the equalizing goal with a header for the 1-1 draw against AC Port of Spain. Since coming on to replace Sherman Augustin, he contributed with 2 shots (1 goal and 1 shot on target) and completed all of his 5 passes.

Zaieem Scott (ATG). Made 8 saves in the 1-1 draw against AC Port of Spain in Round 3, which includes a penalty save against captain Duane Muckette. He completed 13 saves and 6 clearances in the 2 matches of the CONCACAF Caribbean Cup.

Malcolm Stewart (VIN). Leads the shooting category (6) in the current competition. He was influential in Grenades' first goal in the CCC 2024, against Cibao FC (1 assist). The forward was the top scorer of the team (3) in the Caribbean Club Shield 2024.
