

# 2024 CONCACAF W Gold Cup

### **Colombia vs. Brazil / Group B**

Snapdragon Stadium, San Diego, CA February 25

All-time series in the CONMEBOL Copa América: Brazil wins the series JJ-6 JG-5 JE-1 JP-0 (GF-23 GC-1) Brazil won the only game they faced in the Pan American Games 4-0

**Other matches in history**: They were opponents in an international friendly in 2012 with Brazil's victory of 2-1 at the Stade du Lussy, Châtel-Saint-Denis (14-JUL-2012). Brazil also won the match at the South American Women's Games Chile 2014: 2-1 at the Estadio Bicentenario Municipal de La Florida, Santiago de Chile (12-MAR-2014).

# **Colombia (COL)**

Defeated Panama 6-0 in their debut in the W Gold Cup and reached 3 games without losing or conceding goals (0-0 and 1-0 vs. New Zealand in international friendlies, were the previous ones).

From 2022 onwards, they have played 37 matches across all competitions and only lost 8, with 2 of those defeats occurring in the last FIFA World Cup (1-0 vs. Morocco and 2-1 vs. England).

Colombia has kept a clean sheet in 60% of their last 10 matches across all competitions. They only conceded goals in one of their last 5 matches (3-0 vs. United States).

Players to watch:



**Manuela Pavi**. Scored a brace in the 6-0 victory against Panama, in addition to (5) shots. María Usme. Provided two assists, made 4 shots, and scored a goal against Panama.

**Manuela Vanegas**. Scored a goal, provided an assist, had four shots, two ball recoveries, one clearance, and 79 passes in the first match of Group B against Panama.

**Daniela Arias**. Was the player with the most accurate passes (106) and total passes (110) in the first match in Concacaf W with a shooting accuracy of 96% and 2 ball recoveries.



Brasil defeated Puerto Rico 1-0 in their debut and reached 2 consecutive victories without conceding goals.

Gabi Nunes (who had scored in the 4-0 victory against Nicaragua in their last match of 2023 in an international friendly).

Brazil won 7 of their last 11 matches across all competitions and only drew (0-0) against Jamaica in the FIFA World Cup Australia/New Zealand 2023.

They scored 7 of their last 10 goals in the second half and managed to keep a clean sheet in 6 of their 10 matches.

Their last 5 conceded goals were against Japan in the International Friendlies at the end of 2023 (4-3 victory and 2-0 defeat).

#### Players to watch:

**Gabi Nunes**. In just 19 minutes on the field, she scored the winning goal against Puerto Rico in addition to two shots.

**Adriana Leal**. Provided the assist for Nunes' goal. Played 85 minutes against Puerto Rico where she made two shots. She was one of Brazil's top scorers with (5) in the CONMEBOL Copa América 2022.

Debinha. Along with her teammate Bia Zaneratto, she made (5) shots against Puerto Rico. She



was a champion in the CONMEBOL Copa América in Chile 2018 (3 goals in 7 matches) and Colombia 2022 (5 goals in 6 appearances). She scored 1 goal vs France in the FIFA World Cup Australia/New Zealand 2023.

**Júlia Bianchi**. She was the player with the most passes (56) against Puerto Rico with a 90% accuracy rate, also made one shot, one ball recovery, and 2 clearances.
