Guatemala vs Cayman Islands



Guatemala and the Cayman Islands will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.

For Guatemala, this will be the third time facing a Caribbean national team in the history of the Qualifiers, having won both previous matches:

Results:

A 3-1 victory against Curaçao in Group D of the Caribbean & Central America Preliminary Phase at Estadio Nacional de Fútbol de Managua (NCA) on January 27, 2025. Goals for Guatemala were scored by **Allison Mayorga**, **Linda Galindo**, and **Waleska Franco**, while **Jeandrelys Alexandre** scored for Curaçao.

A 5-0 win against Anguilla in Group D of the Caribbean & Central America Preliminary Phase at Estadio Nacional de Fútbol de Managua (NCA) on January 29, 2025. Goals were scored by **Linda Galindo**, an own goal by **Keanna Vanterpool**, **Emily Patzán**, an own goal by **Safiyah Gaskin**, and **Victoria Godoy**.

In the Preliminary Round, Guatemala lost its most recent match, a 7-0 defeat against El Salvador in Group D of the Caribbean & Central America Preliminary Phase on January 31, 2025, at Estadio Nacional de Fútbol de Managua (NCA). El Salvador's goals were scored by **Maya Buerger** twice, **Angelina Carrillo** twice, **Ava Rodríguez**, **Audrina Santos**, and an own goal by **Yenifer Rodríguez**.

For the Cayman Islands, this will be the third time facing a Central American national team in the history of the tournament in any phase, following defeats against Costa Rica (7-0) in the Final Tournament, Group B, on March 10, 2010, and a 12-0 loss to El Salvador in the Caribbean & Central America Preliminary Phase of the 2024 edition, Group A, on August 26, 2023. Goals for the Salvadoran youth side were scored by **Keila Lino**, **Breanna Medina** twice, **Alyssa Jurado**, **Janelle Torres**, **Camila Brower**, **Giselle Márquez**, **Nahomy Portillo**, and **Beatriz Ramos**.



Haiti vs Antigua & Barbuda

Haiti and Antigua & Barbuda will meet again in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers. In their previous encounter, Haiti earned a 6-0 victory on September 20, 2013, in Port-au-Prince (HAI), in Group A of Round Two of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase.

Haiti will face a Caribbean national team in the Preliminary Round for the 16th time in the history of the Qualifiers. The Haitian side carries a streak of four consecutive victories in this phase, the third-longest such run in the history of the Preliminary Rounds, following sequences in 2010 (one win), 2013 (three wins), 2016 (four wins), 2018 (two wins), and 2024 (two wins).

For Antigua & Barbuda, this will be the eighth time facing a Caribbean national team in the Preliminary Round. The team has failed to win any of those matches (D-2 L-5). The most recent result was a 1-1 draw against Saint Lucia on August 26, 2017, in Round One of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Gros Islet (LCA).



Antigua & Barbuda vs Guatemala

It will be the first time that Antigua & Barbuda and Guatemala meet in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.

Antigua & Barbuda will face a Central American national team for the first time in the history of its participations in the Qualifiers, with Guatemala becoming opponent #12 across all phases.

Guatemala will face a Caribbean national team in the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers for the first time in its history. However, Guatemala has previously faced Caribbean opponents in the Final Tournament, posting a record of two wins and four losses. The two most recent matches against Caribbean national teams ended in defeats for the Central American side during the Championship Phase at Estadio Olímpico Félix Sánchez in the Dominican Republic:

A 2-0 loss to Cuba on April 26, 2022, with goals scored by **Ainachy Montalvo** and **Dalia Ledesma** for Cuba.

A 3-1 loss to Haiti on April 28, 2022. Guatemala's goal was scored by **Flor Perla**, while Haiti's goals came from **Ancie-Love Houanche**, **Ronise Joseph**, and **Walandjina Cyriaque**.

Guatemala's most recent victory against a Caribbean national team was a 7-0 win over Grenada on March 7, 2016, nearly 10 years ago, at the National Stadium of Grenada in St. George's (GRA), in Group A of the Final Tournament. Goals were scored by **Adriana Ordóñez**, **Niurka Oliva** twice, **Kellin Mayén**, **María del Pilar Herrarte**, an own goal by **Resheda Charles**, and **Didra Martínez**.



Saint Lucia vs Haiti

It will be a first-ever meeting in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers between Saint Lucia and Haiti.

For Saint Lucia, this will be the fourth match against Caribbean national teams in the history of the Qualifiers. The team has never won, recording two defeats and one draw. The most recent match was a 1-1 draw against Antigua & Barbuda on August 26, 2017, in Group C of Round One of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Gros Islet (LCA). The goal for Saint Lucia was scored by **Vionce Weekes**, while **Jada Benjamin** found the net for Antigua & Barbuda.

The Haiti national team will face two Caribbean national teams (Antigua & Barbuda and Saint Lucia) in the same group in the history of the Qualifiers for the first time since 2024, when it faced Barbados, earning a 12-0 victory on August 27, 2023. Goals included own goals by Unesty Waithe and Zhane Niewsam, along with strikes from **Derline Saindate** three times, **Lourdjina Ettiene** three times, **Aslie Laguerre**, **Yvena Murat**, and **Pierreligne Nazon**.

Haiti also defeated Cuba 6-0 on August 29, 2023, with goals by **Dalachy Pierre**, **Lourdjina Ettiene** twice, **Pierreligne Nazon**, and **Derline Saindate**.



Guatemala vs Saint Lucia

Guatemala and Saint Lucia will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.

For the first time in the history of its participations, Guatemala will have two Caribbean opponents in the same group in the Preliminary Round (Antigua & Barbuda and Saint Lucia). Guatemala has previously faced Caribbean national teams in the Championship Phase.

Saint Lucia will face a Central American national team for the first time, with Guatemala becoming its seventh opponent overall.



Antigua & Barbuda vs Cayman Islands

Antigua & Barbuda and the Cayman Islands will meet again for the second time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers. In their previous encounter, the Cayman Islands

earned a 3-0 victory in the inaugural tournament (2008) on November 20, 2007, in Group B of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase.

For Antigua & Barbuda, this will be the eighth time facing a Caribbean national team in the history of the Qualifiers, with all such meetings taking place in Preliminary Rounds. In its last four matches against Caribbean opponents, Antigua & Barbuda has recorded one defeat, two victories, and one draw. The wins came with a 3-0 result against the U.S. Virgin Islands on September 24, 2013, and a 2-1 victory over Aruba on August 22, 2017.

The Cayman Islands will face a Caribbean national team for the 13th time in the history of the Qualifiers in the Preliminary Round. In its most recent match in this phase, the Cayman Islands earned a 4-0 victory against St. Vincent & the Grenadines on January 31, 2025, at Estadio Centroamericano de Mayagüez in Mayagüez (PUR), in Group A of the Caribbean & Central America Preliminary Phase, with goals by **Clara de Quintal** three times and **Olivia Ridley**.



Saint Lucia vs Antigua & Barbuda

Saint Lucia and Antigua & Barbuda will meet for the second time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers. The previous meeting ended in a 1-1 draw in the Caribbean Preliminary Phase, Group C, on August 26, 2017, at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Gros Islet (LCA). Vionce Weeks scored for Saint Lucia, while Jada Benjamin found the net for Antigua & Barbuda.

Saint Lucia will face two Caribbean national teams in the same group of the Qualifiers for the second time in its history, after sharing Group 4 in the 2016 edition, where it lost both matches, 14-0 against Jamaica on July 17, 2015, and 3-0 against Barbados on July 19, 2015.

Antigua & Barbuda will share a group with two Caribbean national teams for the third time, following the 2013 edition. In the Preliminary Phase, Round One, the team suffered a 4-1 defeat against Trinidad & Tobago on August 16, 2013, and recorded a 0-0 draw against St. Kitts & Nevis on August 18, 2013. In the same Preliminary Phase, but in Round Two, Antigua & Barbuda shared a group and lost both matches, 6-0 against Haiti on September 20, 2013, and 5-0 against Puerto Rico on September 2, 2013.



Cayman Islands vs Haiti

The Cayman Islands and Haiti will meet for the third time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, with one victory recorded by each side.

In the 2010 edition, Haiti earned a 1-0 win in Group B of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase on November 6, 2009. Later, in the 2010 Championship Phase, the Cayman Islands defeated Haiti 1-0 in Group B on March 14, 2010, at Estadio Alejandro Morera Soto in Alajuela (CRC), with a goal by **Alyssa Chin**.



Cayman Islands vs Saint Lucia



The Cayman Islands and Saint Lucia will meet for the first time in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.

For the Cayman Islands, this will be the second time sharing a group with three Caribbean national teams in the history of the Qualifiers (Haiti, Saint Lucia, and Antigua & Barbuda), after the 2016 edition, in which the team suffered defeats of 6-0 against Cuba on July 15, 2015, and 3-2 against the Dominican Republic on July 17, 2015, and earned a 2-0 victory against The Bahamas on July 19, 2015.

Saint Lucia will face an overseas territory national team for the third time in the history of the Qualifiers. The team lost 3-0 to Bermuda in the 2018 edition, in the Caribbean Preliminary Phase, Round One, on August 22, 2017, at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Gros Islet (LCA), with goals by **LeiLanni Nesbeth, Jaden Masters**, and an own goal.

Saint Lucia defeated Aruba 5-0 on August 24, 2017, in the 2018 edition, Group C of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase, Round One, at the Daren Sammy Cricket Ground in Gros Islet (LCA), with goals by **Ilana Lashley, Cassandra Sheherd, Vionce Weekes, Britanya St. Prix, and Krysan St. Louis**.



Haiti vs Guatemala



Haiti leads the series against Guatemala in the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers with two victories. This will be the first time the two teams meet in the Preliminary Round.

The first meeting was a 3-2 victory on March 5, 2016, in Group A at Estadio Atlético de Granada in St. George's (GRA), with goals by **Mikerline Saint-Felix** twice and **Nérilia Mondésir**, while **María del Pilar Herrarte** and **Kellin Mayén** scored for Guatemala.

The most recent meeting was a 3-1 victory in Group H at Estadio Panamericano de San Cristóbal (DOM) on April 28, 2022. Haiti's goals were scored by **Ancie-Love Houanche, Ronise Joseph, and Walandjina Cyriaque**, while Flor de **María Perla** scored for Guatemala.
