



Jamaica 1-1 Guyana



- This marked the **second all-time meeting** between **Jamaica and Guyana** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers and the **first draw** between the two sides. Their previous encounter ended in a **5–0 win for Jamaica** on **Matchday 2 of the Final Quadrangular** of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase on **December 1, 2011**, played at the **Anthony Spaulding Stadium in Kingston (Jamaica)**, with goals by **Shadie Shirley (3)**, **Tiffany Robinson**, and **Nicola Broderick**.
- Nycolette Predergas (JAM) scored her **first goal** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers during the **Preliminary Round**.
- This result represented **Jamaica's first draw in its last four Preliminary Round matches** of the tournament. During that stretch, Jamaica recorded only **one victory**, a **6–0 win against St. Kitts & Nevis** on **Matchday 2 of Group E** on **January 30, 2025**, played at the **National Football Stadium in Managua (Nicaragua)**, with goals by **Kiana Wilson (3)**, **Brianna Turner**, **Ella Provost-Heron**, and **Shauntai Pryce**.
- It was the **10th “debut” match** for **Jamaica** in the history of the Qualifiers, as the team remains **unbeaten** with a record of **8 wins and 2 draws**. It also marked **Jamaica's second draw in its last three “debut” matches** in the competition's history, following **1–1 draws against Panama (August 26, 2023)** and **Guyana (January 25, 2026)**.
- **Guyana** recorded **two consecutive matches without defeat** for the second time in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, following a **7–1 victory against Turks and Caicos Islands (January 31, 2025)** and the **1–1 draw against Jamaica (January 25, 2026)**. The previous occurrence came with a **1–1 draw against Curaçao (August 17, 2011)** and a **2–0 win against Anguilla (August 21, 2011)**.
- Guyana recorded its **second-ever draw in a “debut” match** in the history of the tournament, following the **1–1 draw against Curaçao** on **August 17, 2011**, in **Group C** of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase (Round One). That match was played at the **Providenciales Stadium in Providenciales (Turks and Caicos Islands)**; **Samantha Statia** scored for Curaçao, while **Sara Vaughan** netted for Guyana.
- **Alexaudria Chasles (GUY)** reached **four goals** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers during the **Preliminary Round**. It was also her **first goal against Jamaica**, further cementing her status as **Guyana's all-time leading scorer** in the Preliminary Round of the competition.



Guatemala 1-0 Cayman Islands

- **Emery Aguilar (GUA)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the Qualifiers. The goal also marked **Guatemala's 15th goal** scored in **group play of the Preliminary Rounds**, since **2015**, when the team began competing at this stage of the tournament.
- Guatemala has recorded **three wins in its last four Preliminary Round matches** of the Qualifiers (3W-1L). The lone defeat during this span was a **7-0 loss to El Salvador** on **January 31, 2025**, in **Matchday 3 of Group D**, played at the **National Football Stadium in Managua (Nicaragua)**.

Goals in that match were scored by **Maya Buerger (2)**, **Angelina Carrillo (2)**, **Ava Rodríguez**, **Audrina Santos**, and **Yenifer Rodríguez (own goal)**.

- This result represented **Guatemala's fourth victory in tournament "debut" matches** and the **first time** the team has won a match of this type by a **1-0 scoreline**.
- It was the **second time** Guatemala defeated a **Caribbean national team** in a tournament "debut" match, following the **3-1 win against Curaçao on January 27, 2025**, and the **1-0 victory against the Cayman Islands on January 25, 2026**.
- The **Cayman Islands** played their **third match against Central American teams** in the history of the tournament during the Preliminary Round, maintaining a record of **three defeats (3/3)**, **no goals scored**, and **20 goals conceded**: **7-0 vs. Costa Rica (March 10, 2010)**, **12-0 vs. El Salvador (August 2, 2023)**, and **1-0 vs. Guatemala (January 25, 2026)**.
- The Cayman Islands suffered their **fourth consecutive defeat in tournament "debut" matches** in the history of the competition (across all phases). In those matches, the team failed to score: **0-6 vs. Cuba (July 15, 2015)**, **0-12 vs. El Salvador (August 26, 2023)**, **0-2 vs. Bermuda (January 27, 2025)**, and **0-1 vs. Guatemala (January 25, 2026)**.
- This marked the **ninth occasion in 21 matches played** by the **Cayman Islands** in any phase of the Qualifiers in which the team **failed to score**, in the history of the tournament.



Cuba 4-3 Grenada

- **Yaiselis López (CUB)** reached **six goals** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers during the **Preliminary Round**. It also marked the **first time** she scored **four goals in a single match** for her national team at this stage.

- With her **six goals**, **Yaiselis López** became **Cuba's all-time leading scorer** in the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers, breaking the tie with **Yilianny Sablón (5)** and **Lilian Pérez (5)**, both achieved in **2015**.
- **Yaiselis López** became the **second Cuban player** to score **four goals in a single match** for her national team in the history of the Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round, following **Cecil Tamayo**, who accomplished the feat against **Guyana** on **August 13, 2017**, in **Matchday 3 of Group D**, at the **Synthetic Track and Field Facility in Leonora (Guyana)**.
- Cuba recorded its **third consecutive victory in tournament “debut” matches** in the history of the Qualifiers, marking the **best streak ever** for the Cuban side in this category. Meanwhile, **Grenada** became the team to **score the most goals against Cuba** in tournament “debut” matches (**three goals**), surpassing the **two goals scored by Haiti** in a **2–0 loss on April 24, 2022**, a debut match played in the **Final Round**, with goals by **Chritlove Caramus** and **Walandjina Cyriaque**.
- It was the **first time** Cuba won a match by a **4–3 scoreline** in any phase of the Qualifiers. The match also marked Cuba's **17th encounter against Caribbean national teams** in the Preliminary Round, earning its **10th victory**.
- **Grenada** suffered its **sixth consecutive defeat** in the Qualifiers across **all phases**, establishing the **worst losing streak** in the nation's history in this competition.
- **Alexys Hipolite (GRN)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round.
- **Arielle Grant (GRN)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round.
- **Jazmin Lewis (GRN)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round.
- It marked the **first time** **Grenada** scored **three goals** in a Qualifiers match in **any phase** and still lost the game, representing the **fourth-highest goal total** scored by the team in a defeat.



Haití 6-1 Antigua & Barbuda

- **Keisha Gue (HAI)** scored her **first career brace** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, also recording her **first two goals** at this stage of the tournament.
- **Kerdina Lamour (HAI)** also registered her **first brace** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers, scoring her **first two goals** in this phase.

- **Kyrah Lormil (HAI)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round.
- **Adjani Kamanzi-Mondestin (HAI)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers in the Preliminary Round.
- This marked **Haiti's second victory in two matches** against **Antigua & Barbuda** in the history of the Qualifiers. In the previous meeting, Haiti earned a **6–0 win** on **Matchday 1 of Group A** of the Caribbean Preliminary Phase (Round Two), in a match played in **Port-au-Prince (Haiti)**.
- Haiti recorded its **seventh victory in seven tournament “debut” matches** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, remaining **unbeaten** in this category. It was also only the **second time** Haiti conceded a goal in debut matches, following the goal allowed against **Curaçao** in a **7–1 victory** on **July 17, 2015**, in **Group 2**, played at the **Stade Sylvio Cator in Port-au-Prince (Haiti)**.

In that match, Haiti's goals were scored by **Nérilia Mondésir (3)**, **Mellisa Dacius**, **Melchie Dumornay**, and **Dolores Jean-Thomas (2)**, while **Sjulienne Martina** scored for Curaçao.

- This was the **second time** Haiti won a Qualifiers match by a **6–1 scoreline**, following the victory against the **Dominican Republic** on **August 25, 2013**, in **Matchday 3 of Group III**.
- **Antigua & Barbuda** reached **15 matches played** across all phases of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, holding an all-time record of **9 losses, 3 draws, and 3 wins**.
- Haiti became the **national team to score six goals most often against Antigua & Barbuda** in the history of the Qualifiers, following defeats of **0–6 (September 20, 2013)** and **1–6 (January 25, 2026)**.
- **Keitonya Skepple (ATG)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.



Honduras 3-1 Aruba



- **Alexandra Merriam (HON)** reached **four goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers and also recorded her **first brace** at this stage of the tournament.
- **Allisson Suazo (HON)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.
- With her **four goals** in the Preliminary Round, **Alexandra Merriam** tied for **second place** among **Honduras' all-time leading scorers** in this phase, alongside **Larissa Arias, Karla Cálix, and Susan Henríquez**, all achieved in **2021**.

- **Alexandra Merriam** recorded the **10th brace** for **Honduras** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers, and the **sixth against Caribbean national teams**. Previous braces were scored by **Galeen López, Larissa Arias, and Susan Henríquez** against the **Turks and Caicos Islands** in **2021**, by **Anyelí Rodríguez** against **Guyana** in **2021**, and by **Larissa Arias** against **Anguilla** in **2021**.
- This marked **Honduras' 15th match** in the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers, earning its **ninth victory** at this stage. It was also the **first time in the nation's history** that Honduras recorded **four consecutive wins** in the Preliminary Round: **2–0 vs. Belize (January 27, 2025)**, **4–0 vs. U.S. Virgin Islands (January 29, 2025)**, **1–0 vs. Trinidad & Tobago (January 31, 2025)**, and **3–1 vs. Aruba (January 25, 2026)**.
- **Adannayah Breinburg (ARU)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round. It was also the **first goal ever scored by Aruba against a Central American national team** in the history of the tournament.
- **Aruba** suffered its **seventh consecutive defeat** in the history of the Qualifiers across **all phases**, marking its **eighth loss in nine matches played** in the competition.



- **Cameron Mora (CRC)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers.
- **Avril Pérez (CRC)** recorded her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers.
- **Nubia Medina (CRC)** reached **six goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers and, for the **first time**, scored **five goals in a single match**, all at this stage of the tournament.
- **Lucía Paniagua (CRC)** reached **eight goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the Qualifiers and, for the **first time**, scored **four goals in a single match**, all in this phase.
- **Emma Azofeifa (CRC)** recorded her **first career brace** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament, scoring her **first two goals** at this stage.
- **Nicole Hernández (CRC)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.
- **Gilliam López (CRC)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.
- **Isska Chaverri (CRC)** reached **two goals** scored in the history of the Qualifiers during the Preliminary Round, following the goal scored against **Grenada** on **January 30, 2025**, in **Matchday 2 of Group F**, in Costa Rica's **7–0 victory**.

- The **Costa Rica national team** recorded its **largest victory ever** in any phase of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers, surpassing the **15–0 win against Belize** on **November 13, 2015**. This result also stands as the **largest victory by any Central American team in any phase** in the history of the tournament.
- Costa Rica earned its **ninth consecutive victory in tournament “debut” matches** in the history of the Qualifiers, marking the **eighth occasion** in which the team kept a **clean sheet** in this category.
- The **British Virgin Islands** suffered their **seventh defeat in seven matches played** in the history of the Concacaf Women's Under-17 Qualifiers. This result marked the **second-largest defeat** in the team's history in the competition, only behind the **24–0 loss to Haiti** on **November 2, 2009**.
