



Cavalier FC (JAM) vs. Miscellaneous Police FC (TRI)

Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston, JAM

Group A, Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston, Jamaica, Thursday, August 29 2024.

They will face each other for the first time in the Caribbean Cup and in their history.

Cavalier will face an opponent from Trinidad and Tobago for the 3rd time and remains undefeated with 1 win and 1 draw. The current runners-up of the Caribbean Cup in their last encounter against teams from Trinidad and Tobago defeated the newcomer's AC Port of Spain 2-1 on August 31, 2023, with goals from Jalmaro Calvin (8') and Christopher Ainsworth (60') for the Jamaicans, and Duane Muckette (71') for the Trinidadians.

Police FC will face a Jamaican club for the first time in official tournaments.



CAVALIER (JAM)

Cavalier FC remained undefeated in the group stage of the 2023 edition with 4 wins and 1 draw, securing all the points at home (2-1 vs. AC Port of Spain and 3-0 vs. Moca). They will play at home again after winning 2-0 away against Mt. Pleasant.

Cavalier FC failed to score in their last two home matches in the semifinals and final (0-0 vs. Harbour View and 0-2 vs. Robinhood).

In addition to being the runner-up in the 2023 edition, they were the team with the most goals scored, totaling 16 with an average of 2 goals per game. Shaniel Thomas was the top scorer with 8 goals (5 from open play, 2 from penalties, and 1 header).

Best result in the CCC: Runner-up in 2023.

Record in the CCC: 9 games played, 5 wins, 2 draws, 2 losses (GF-18, GA-7).

Top scorers in the CCC: Shaniel Thomas (JAM) 8, Jalmaro Calvin (ATG) 3, Christopher Ainsworth (JAM) 2.

Assists in the CCC: Jalmaro Calvin (ATG) 4, Nicholas Hamilton (JAM) 2, Orlando Russell (JAM) 2.

Highest-scoring victory: 5-0 vs. Harbour View (Shaniel Thomas, Jalmaro Calvin, own goal by Keven Clarke, Jeovanni Laing, and Dwayne Allen), Semifinals (first leg), Sabina Park Stadium, Kingston (October 24, 2023).

Top scorers in the 2024 edition: Christopher Ainsworth (JAM) 1, Shaquille Stein (SUR).

Assists in the 2024 edition: Jalmaro Calvin (ATG) 1.

Goal scoring opportunities (5). Shots on target (2).

Players to watch:

- **Shaquille Stein (SUR):** Scored the second goal in the win against Mt Pleasant and made 2 shots (1 on target and 1 goal). The midfielder scored 4 goals in 6 appearances in the last season of the Jamaican Premier League.

- **Jalmaro Calvin (ATG):** Has been involved in 7 goals over two editions of the Caribbean Cup (3 goals and 4 assists). He is the team's lead assist provider with 4. He scored 13 goals in 28 appearances in the 2023/24 Jamaican Premier League.

- **Jeadine White (JAM):** Thanks to his 6 saves against Mt. Pleasant, he achieved the fourth clean sheet in the Caribbean Cup.



POLICE FC (TRI)

Miscellaneous Police FC will play their second match in the Caribbean Cup after drawing 1-1 against Real Hope FC (Angelo Exilus; Kwesi Allen).

Although they drew 1-1 in their first match, they surpassed Real Hope in possession with 52%. The team coached by Wendell Joshep (TRI) made 400 passes with an accuracy of 87%.

Top scorers in the CCC: Kwesi Allen (TRI) 1.

Assists in the CCC: Elijah Belgrave (TRI) 1.

Players with most appearances in the CCC: Adrian Foncette, Alvin Jones, Robert Primus, Mekeil Williams, Ross Russell Jr., Simeon Bailey, Joevin Jones, Jabari Mitchell, Ezekiel Kesar, Mark Ramdeen, Kevon Woodley, Elijah Belgrave, Jordan Riley, Kareem Freitas, Kwesi Allen, Kadeem Hutchinson (1 appearance each).

Saves: Adrian Foncette (TRI) 1.

Goal scoring opportunities (6). Shots on target (2).

Players to watch:

- **Robert Primus (TRI):** Previously played 4 matches in the Caribbean Cup with AC Port Spain in 2023, where he made six ball recoveries and 12 clearances. In his first match with Police, he made 41 passes and completed two clearances.

- **Kwesi Allen (TRI):** Scored the first goal for Miscellaneous Police FC with a header as a substitute against Real Hope. Achieved 100% shooting accuracy.

- **Kevon Woodley (TRI):** Made 50% of Police FC's shots against Real Hope (3 out of 6). The forward had a passing accuracy of 92%.
