How did they qualify for the Preliminaries? They won Group A in League A.

Record in the Concacaf Gold Cup Qualifiers: Played 6, Won 5, Drawn 0, Lost 1 (Goals For 20, Goals Against 2).

Players to Watch:

Otesha Charles: Had participation in 9 of the team's last 16 goals (6 goals and 2 assists). She was the player with the most shots (15) for Guyana in the qualifiers and scored a hat-trick in the 9-0 victory against Dominica.

Jalade Trim: Scored 2 goals and had 11 shots in the qualifiers. Played in all 6 matches and scored a brace in the 5-0 victory against Dominica.

Brianne Desa: Scored 3 goals from 8 shots and was one of the players with the most assists (4). She scored a goal against Antigua & Barbuda and twice against Dominica.



How did they qualify for the Preliminaries? They won Group C in League B.

Mia Asenjo: She scored 3 goals in 2 matches. The forward netted 4 goals in 6 appearances at the 2020 Concacaf Women's Under-20 Championship held in the Dominican Republic.

Winibian Peralta: She concluded the qualifiers with 20 shots (10% effectiveness) and scored 2 goals in 6 matches. She was the player with the most corner kicks (50) and the most fouls against her (18).

Players to Watch:

Melchie Dumornay: She was the top scorer of the team with 8 goals, with a 44% shot accuracy. In addition to her 8 goals, she provided 1 assist and had 18 shots in the group stage.

Nérilia Mondésir: Scored 6 goals, provided 8 assists, and had 21 shots in Group C of League A (against Costa Rica and Saint Kitts and Nevis x2). She scored 1 goal in the Concacaf W 2022 and captained Haiti in their first participation in a FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia/New Zealand 2023.

Batcheba Louis: Scored 5 goals in 19 shots in the qualifiers for the Concacaf Gold Cup W. She also scored 5 goals from 11 shots in the 13-0 victory against Saint Kitts and Nevis in Basseterre on Matchday 4 of Group C in League A.



Puerto Rico (PUR)

How did they qualify for the Preliminaries? Second Place in Group A of League A.

Sydney Martinez: She was one of the top goalkeepers in the Concacaf Gold Cup W qualifiers with 18 saves, tying with Alexia Estrada of Guatemala and only surpassed by Kyra Dickinson of Saint Kitts and Nevis.

Jillienne Aguilera: Scored 1 goal and had 6 shots. She scored her goal in the 1-2 victory against Trinidad and Tobago.

Skylynn Rodríguez: Scored the first goal in the 1-2 victory against Trinidad and Tobago in Port of Spain. She was a starter in the last 3 matches of the qualifiers for the Concacaf Gold Cup W.

Victoria Sánchez: Scored 3 goals and provided 2 assists in 6 appearances. She scored 1 goal in 4 appearances in the qualifiers for the Concacaf W Championship 2022. She also played in the Sub-17 (2 goals in 5 matches) and Sub-20 (4 goals in 5 games) in the Dominican Republic 2022.

How were the goals scored? From open play (3), Penalty (2), Header (1).

Chances to score goals (49). Shots on target (26).

Saves: 18. Goalkeepers: Alexia Estrada (18).

Clean sheets: 0.

Biggest win: 3-2 vs. Panama (League A / Group B - Matchday 2).

Players to Watch:

Ana Lucía Martínez: She was Guatemala's top scorer in the qualifiers with 3 goals. She scored a brace against Panama and one goal against Jamaica.

Aisha Solórzano: Scored 1 goal and provided 1 assist and had the most shots among Guatemalan players in the qualifiers with 14.

Leslie Ramírez: Scored 1 goal from 8 shots in the qualifiers for the Concacaf Gold Cup W. She scored the first goal in the 2-2 draw against Jamaica in Kingston and netted 2 goals against the United States Virgin Islands in the qualifiers for the Concacaf W Championship 2022.
