

Police FC (TRI) vs. Arnett Gardens (JAM)

Thursday, September 19, 2024, Group A, Hasely Crawford Stadium, Port of Spain, TRI

They will face each other for the first time in the Caribbean Cup.

Week 2: Cavalier SC (JAM) 4-1 Police FC (TRI)

Kevon Woodlwy (TRI) of Police FC scored his 1st goal in the CCC, and Kevon Woodlwy (TRI) scored the 2nd goal in the history of the CCC for his club.

The defeat against Cavalier FC was the first for Police FC in the history of the CCC and made them the first team from Trinidad and Tobago to achieve a loss and a draw in their debut tournament in their first two matches.

With Cavalier SC's (JAM) victory over Police FC, the clubs from Jamaica have a streak of 6 consecutive undefeated games in the history of the CCC (1 draw, 5 wins against clubs from Trinidad and Tobago, with Cavalier SC securing the last 2 wins and a streak of 3 consecutive unbeaten games (last 3) against opponents from Trinidad and Tobago (1 draw, 2 wins).



Miscellaneous Police FC will play their first home game in the 2024 CCC. In their 2 matches, they surpassed their opponents in possession of the ball (52% vs. Real Hope FA and 56% vs. Cavalier).

The club from the city of Saint James will seek their first victory in the competition after securing 1 point from a possible 6 in the tournament: 1-1 vs. Real Hope (Angelo Exilus; Kwesi Allen) and a 4-1 defeat vs. Cavalier (Shaquille Stein x2 and Dwayne Atkinson x2; Kevon Woodley).

They scored 100% of their goals in the CCC with headers. Kwesi Allen (vs. Real Hope FA) and Kevon Woodley (vs. Cavalier).

Top scorers in the CCC: Kwesi Allen (TRI) 1, Kevon Woodley (TRI).

Assists in the CCC: Elijah Belgrave (TRI) 1, Alvin Jones (TRI).

Saves in the CCC: Adrian Foncette (TRI) 2.

Opportunities to score (14). Shots on target (7).

Players to watch:

Simeon Bailey (TRI). Leads in passes with (95). He recovered 3 balls and completed 88% of his passes in 191 minutes on the pitch.

Kwesi Allen (TRI). Scored the first headed goal for Miscellaneous Police FC coming off the bench against Real Hope. Achieved 100% shooting effectiveness in 28 minutes across two appearances.

Kevon Woodley (TRI). Scored a goal against Cavalier FC in Group A. The 38-year-old striker made 50% of the Trinidadian team's shots in the CCC 2024 (7 out of 14).



Week 2: Arnett Gardens (JAM) 1x2 Mount Pleasant (JAM)

Arnett Gardens (JAM) ended a streak of 3 consecutive unbeaten games in the CCC (2W-1D). The defeat ended three consecutive home wins.

Shai Smith's (JAM) goal for Arnett Gardens (JAM) was the 40th goal scored for the Jamaican club in CCC history, and it was also his first goal in the tournament.

This is the first time Arnett Gardens (JAM) has faced a club from their own country (Jamaica) and lost.

Arnett Gardens (JAM) started the tournament with a defeat, for the first time since participating in the CCC, ending a streak of 4 debut games without a loss (3W-1D).

The club Arnett Gardens (JAM) conceded a goal in debut games for the second time in its history, not having conceded since November 5, 2003, against Jong Colombia (CUW) more than 20 years ago, during which Kevin Jenson scored.

The 2024 Caribbean Club Shield champion scored their only goal of the CCC 2024 with a header (Shai Smith vs. Mt. Pleasant on the second day of Group A).

The winner of 5 titles in the Jamaica Premier League achieved 62% ball possession in the first match against Mt Pleasant. The Kingston club totaled 396 passes with an accuracy of 83%.

Top scorers in the CCC: Shai Smith (JAM) 1.

Assists in the CCC: Kimani Arbouine (JAM) 1.

Saves in the CCC: Asher Hutchinson (JAM) 6.

Opportunities to score (11). Shots on goal (5).

Players to watch:

Kimani Arbouine (JAM). Provided an assist that led to Shai Smith's headed goal and took (3) shots in Arnett Gardens' first match.

Shai Smith (JAM). Scored the only goal (a header) in his CCC debut. The forward completed 21 passes in the debut.

Jamone Shepherd (JAM). Made 2 shots, 3 corner kicks, and (67) passes in addition to (4) ball recoveries against Mt Pleasant (93% pass effectiveness).
