Turks and Caicos Islands v Anguilla

They will face each other for the second time in their history in the Concacaf qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup.

Anguilla 0-0 Turks and Caicos Islands, First Round Concacaf Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Canada, United States, and Mexico 2026, Raymond E. Guishard Stadium, The Valley (March 22, 2024).



Turks and Caicos Islands (TCA)

Record in Concacaf FIFA World Cup qualifiers: GP-14, W- 1, D- 1, L- 12 (GF-6 GA-68).

Top scorers in CWCQ: Widlin Calixte (2), David Lowery (1), Gavin Ginton, Billy Forbes (including an own goal in favor).

Players with the most appearances in CWCQ: Billy Forbes (10), Lenford Singh (9), Philip Shearer (8), Charles Cook (6), Duane Ginton (6).

Biggest win in CWCQ: 2-1 vs. Saint Lucia (David Lowery and Gavin Ginton; Nyhime Gilbert), first round - Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup South Africa 2010, TCIFA National Stadium, Providenciales (February 6, 2008).

After 8 defeats, the Turks and Caicos Islands achieved their first draw in the Concacaf qualifiers.

Their last 2 goals in the qualifiers were penalties scored by Widlin Calixte (against Saint Kitts and Nevis in the First Round of the Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Russia 2018).

Their last 4 goals in the qualifiers were scored in the first round for the FIFA World Cup Russia 2018 against Saint Kitts and Nevis in 2015.



Anguilla (AIA)

Record in Concacaf FIFA World Cup qualifiers: GP- 15, W- 0, D- 2, L- 13 (GF-2 GA-64).

Top scorers in CWCQ: Kenneth Hughes (1), Richard O'Connor.

Players with the most appearances in CWCQ: Girton Connor (10), Jonathan Guishard (7), Kevin Hawley (7), Javille Brooks (6), Ryan Liddie (6), Leon Jeffers (6).

Anguilla is in search of its first victory in the history of qualifiers.

The 0-0 draw in the first match on Friday, March 22, 2024, against the Turks and Caicos Islands ended a streak of 11 consecutive defeats in the Concacaf qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup.

Their 2 draws in the qualifiers were goalless (the previous one against the Dominican Republic in the first round of the Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Germany 2006).

Their two goals were scored by Kenneth Hughes and Richard O'Connor in the two matches against the Bahamas in the first round of the Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Korea/Japan 2002.
