Milestones and Records – January 26, 2026



Suriname 0-8 Panama



- It marked the **first time** the **Suriname national team** conceded **eight goals** in a single match of the tournament in **any phase**.
- **Panama** won its **first two matches** of a tournament edition by the **same scoreline (8–0)** for the **first time in its history in any phase**: **vs. Bonaire on Matchday 1 (January 24, 2026)** and **vs. Suriname on Matchday 2 (January 26, 2026)**.
- **Gabriela Rodríguez (PAN)** reached **three goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament and recorded her **first career brace**.
- **Yasselis Magallón (PAN)** reached **four goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament; it was her **first goal in the current edition**, after scoring **three goals in 2025 (vs. Guyana and vs. Cuba (2))**.
- **Shaday Mow (PAN)** reached **nine goals** in the history of the Qualifiers during the **Preliminary Round**. In the **2026 edition**, she has scored **three goals (2 vs. Bonaire on Matchday 1 and 1 vs. Suriname on Matchday 2)**, matching her output from the **2025 edition (2 vs. Turks and Caicos Islands on Matchday 1 and 1 vs. Guyana on Matchday 2)**.
- **Isabella Rendino (PAN)** reached **two goals** in the Preliminary Round of the tournament and recorded her **first career brace**.
- **Guillehely Distancia (PAN)** and **Naomi Zafrani (PAN)** scored their **first goals** in the competition during the **Preliminary Round**; their goals were Panama's **sixth and seventh penalty goals** in this round.



U.S. Virgin Islands 0-11 Dominican Republics



- The **U.S. Virgin Islands national team** extended its run to **16 consecutive defeats** in the Qualifiers across **any phase**, the **worst losing streak** recorded by **any team** in the history of the tournament.

- The U.S. Virgin Islands suffered their **third-heaviest defeat** in the history of the tournament in any phase, only behind the losses **0–13 vs. Trinidad & Tobago (August 18, 2013)**, **0–13 vs. Trinidad & Tobago (August 23, 2017)**, and **0–22 vs. Haiti (September 22, 2013)**.
 - The **Dominican Republic** recorded its **second-largest victory** in the history of the tournament across any phase, only behind the **17–0 win against Guyana (August 23, 2013)**.
 - The **18 goals** scored by the **Dominican Republic** in its **first two group-stage matches** represent the **second-highest goal total** ever recorded by the team in its **first two matches** of a tournament edition, only behind the **23 goals** scored in **2013: 6–0 vs. Grenada (August 21, 2013)** and **17–0 vs. Guyana (August 23, 2013)**.
 - **Giocarla Durán (DOM)** reached **seven goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the Qualifiers and, for the **first time**, scored **five goals in a single match**.
 - **Jazmyn Díaz (DOM)**, **Emelie Asenjo (DOM)**, and **Delilah Antonini (DOM)** scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.
 - **Kyliz Osorio** recorded her **first own goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament, on this occasion **in favor of the Dominican Republic**.
 - **Gia Fernández (DOM)** scored her **first two goals** in the Preliminary Round of the tournament, recording her **first career brace**.

Bonaire 1-7 Bermuda



- **Daley Outerbridge (BER)** reached **five goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament and recorded her **first career hat trick**.
- **Milan Gibbons-Thomas (BER)** reached **eight goals** in the Preliminary Round of the tournament and recorded her **second brace**, following the one scored against **St. Vincent & the Grenadines on January 29, 2025**.
- **Nila Samuels (BER)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.
- **Evans Welch (BER)** reached **five goals** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament and scored in the **first two matchdays of a single edition** for the first time: **two goals vs. Suriname on Matchday 1** and **one goal vs. Bonaire on Matchday 2**.
- **Shaimarís Mercera (BON)** scored the **first-ever goal for Bonaire** in the Qualifiers in **any phase**.

- It was the **first time Bermuda** scored **seven goals** against a **debuting national team** in the tournament, surpassing the **two goals** scored in the **2–1 win vs. Anguilla on November 15, 2007**.

- This result marked the **third-largest victory** for **Bermuda** in the history of the competition, only behind the **7–0 win vs. Suriname (January 24, 2026)** and the **13–1 victory vs. Aruba (August 26, 2017)**.



Barbados 0-6 El Salvador



- **Kylie Guardado (SLV)** scored her **first two goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament and recorded the **fastest goal of the competition to date**, at **00:39**.

- **Shirley Rivera (SLV)**, **Kaylen Álvarez (SLV)**, **Melanie Menjívar (SLV, penalty)**, and **Arianna Jones (SLV)** each scored their **first goal** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament.

- This marked the **largest defeat ever suffered by Barbados against a Central American national team** in the history of the tournament, in **any phase**.

- **Barbados** recorded **five consecutive defeats** in the tournament, the **worst losing streak** in the history of the Qualifiers for the national team, in **any phase**.

- **El Salvador** recorded **four consecutive victories** in tournament “debut” matches for the **first time in its history**, all without conceding a goal: **6–0 vs. Guatemala (April 24, 2022)**, **12–0 vs. Cayman Islands (August 26, 2023)**, **9–0 vs. Anguilla (January 27, 2025)**, and **6–0 vs. Barbados (January 26, 2026)**.



Dominica 0-9 Nicaragua



- This marked the **third-heaviest defeat** for **Dominica** in the history of the tournament, only behind the **13–0 loss to Trinidad & Tobago (September 14, 2011)** and the **21–0 loss to Canada (August 26, 2023)**.

- For **Nicaragua**, this result represented its **second-largest victory** in the history of the tournament across **any phase**, only behind the **10–0 win against the U.S. Virgin Islands (August 29, 2023)**.

- It was the **first time** Nicaragua scored **15 goals in its first two matches** of a tournament edition in **any phase**: **6–0 vs. Belize (January 24, 2026)** and **9–0 vs. Dominica (January 26, 2026)**.

It also marked the **highest goal total ever** recorded by Nicaragua in its **first two matches** of the tournament, surpassing the **six goals** scored in **2025 (4–0 vs. St. Kitts & Nevis on January 28, 2025, and 2–1 vs. Jamaica on February 1, 2025)**.

- **Stefany Miranda (NCA)** reached **eight goals** in the history of the **Preliminary Round** of the tournament, scored her **first career hat trick**, and became the **first player** to record **four assists in a single match** in the current edition of the tournament.

- **Marian Ruíz (NCA)** and **Mariela Zavala (NCA)** reached their **third goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament and, for the **first time**, both recorded a **brace**.

- **Margarita Collado (NCA)** scored her **first goal** in the history of the Preliminary Round of the tournament.
