

Frazsiers (JAM) vs. Tigres UANL (MEX)

Group A, September 18, 2024, National Stadium, Kingston.



Frazsiers Whip will play their 3rd match in the group stage of the CWCC 2024/25. The Jamaican club lost 5-0 in their first two matches (vs. Alajuelense and CF Monterrey).

For the champions of the Jamaican Women's Premier League 2022/23, it will be their first home match after suffering two away losses.

Coach Courtney Dowdie's (JAM) team made 10 shots in the previous two matches in Group A: 4 shots on goal, 1 against the posts, and 5 off target.

Highlighted players:

- **Nevillegail Able (JAM)**: The 22-year-old captain had 6 ball recoveries, 8 clearances, and made 13 accurate passes in the last game against Monterrey.
- **Davia Richards (JAM)**: Came close to scoring Frazsiers' first goal in the history of the CWCC 2024-25 when her shot against CF Monterrey hit the post. Richards made 36 passes against Monterrey.
- **Italya Robinson (JAM)**: The 16-year-old goalkeeper has made 10 saves and 1 clearance in her 2 matches in the CWCC 2024-25 (she did not concede any goals in the first half of the first match against Alajuelense).



Tigres UANL debuted with a 4-0 victory featuring goals from Maricarmen Reyes, Jennifer Hermoso, Thembi Kgatlana, and Cristina Ferral, against CF Monterrey in the Clásico Regio in Group A, at the Estadio Universitario (August 22, 2024).

The Universitarias lost their two away games in the NWSL x Liga MX Femenil Summer Cup 2024 (2-1 vs. Houston Dash and 4-1 vs. Kansas City Current).

In the 4-0 win against Monterrey, Tigres UANL made 18 shots (9 on target, 1 against the posts, 4 off target, and scored 4 goals). They controlled Monterrey's attack, which only managed to make 7 shots.

Highlighted players:

- **Jenni Hermoso (ESP)**: The world champion with Spain scored a header in the 4-0 victory against CF Monterrey in the Clásico Regio. The Spanish forward made three shots alongside her teammates Alexia Delgado and Thembi Kgatlana.
- **Stephany Mayor (MEX**): The forward provided 2 assists (one in each half) in addition to taking a shot on goal.
- **Jacqueline Ovalle (MEX)**: Directly involved in 2 of the 4 goals against CF Monterrey with 2 assists. The forward also made a shot, 26 passes, and 2 corner kicks.
