Dominican Republic vs. Mexico / Group A

Dignity Health Sports Park, Carson, CA February 23

Mexico and the Dominican Republic have only faced each other once in the Group B of the women's Olympic qualifiers, with a 7-0 victory for Mexico with goals from Luz Saucedo, Marylin Díaz, Jennifer Ruiz x2, and Anisa Guajardo x3) at BC Place, Vancouver (Jan 22, 2012).

The Dominican Republic lost 0-5 in their debut in Group A against the United States with goals from Olivia Moultrie x2, Lynn Williams, Jenna Nighswonger, and Alex Morgan.

Saves: 5. Goalkeepers: Paloma Peña (5). Clean sheets: 0.

Players to watch:

Kathrynn González: Had one shot in the debut against the United States. Scored the goal in the 1-0 victory against Guyana in the Prelims. Contributed 3 goals and 3 assists in 4 matches in the Road to Concacaf W Gold Cup 2024.

Lucía Marte: Had (6) ball recoveries in her first match in Group A. The team captain made 12 successful passes. Led in assists with (4) in RTWGC 2023.

Brianne Reed: Was the player with the most passes with (21) in the debut against the United States (14 of them accurate) and made 7 of the 18 clearances in the first match.

Paloma Peña: With 5 saves prevented a larger score against the USA, made 2 clearances and 18 successful passes. In the Prelims, made 2 saves and a crucial



clearance against Guyana in the Preliminary Round where she kept a clean sheet against Guyana.

Mexico drew 0-0 against Argentina in the opening match of Group A. Team captain Rebeca Bernal missed a penalty kick.

Goal-scoring opportunities vs Argentina (12). Shots on target (5).

Saves: 1. Goalkeeper: Esthefanny Barreras (1). Clean sheets: 1 (0 goals conceded).

Players to watch:

Rebeca Bernal: Made (46) successful passes in the opening match. The team captain had 2 shots including the missed penalty kick in the first half.

María Sánchez: Had (3) shots against Argentina. Scored in the first 2 victories (vs. Puerto Rico and Trinidad) in RTWGC and was the player with the most shots (13) in 3 appearances.

Greta Espinoza: Mexico's defender made 49 total passes and 2 ball recoveries in the debut against Argentina. Scored 1 goal in RTWGC 2024 (vs. Trinidad).

Esthefanny Barreras: Kept a clean sheet in the debut against Argentina with one save, 1 clearance, and 26 successful passes. Has not conceded goals in 6 of her 8 appearances with Mexico (including RTWGC and Pan American Games Chile 2023).
